SRSLY-SAFE HOMES

INTRODUCTION: In response to a growing concern among Dexter residents about the prevalence and perceived acceptance of teen drinking parties hosted by parents, the SRSLY Coalition presents “SRSLY-Safe Homes.” This program will help kids and parents identify other families in and around Dexter who support youth in making healthy choices, and are committed to helping young people stay substance-free.

Families who decide to enroll will have their names listed on the SRSLY website. This will accomplish two important things – practically, it lets kids and parents know which homes are safe for them to hang out and have fun at without worrying about kids using drugs or alcohol. More broadly, it sends a message to the community that parents in Dexter want their kids to grow up safe and substance-free, and kids want to hang out and have fun with their friends without being pressured to use drugs or alcohol.

DEFINITION: A “SRSLY-Safe Home” is a home in which the family has committed to providing a safe and substance-free environment for their children, and any other youth who spend time there. Kids and adults can be confident that minors under the age of 21 will not be offered or allowed to use drugs or alcohol while they are in these families’ homes.

SRSLY membership is encouraged, but not required in order to add your family’s name to the SRSLY-Safe Homes list.

HOW YOUR FAMILY CAN GET ON THE LIST: Families can add their name to the list of SRSLY-Safe Homes by doing one of two things:
